SUBJECT: Improve fit between Handle Halves and Motor Housing Assembly —

"A" series, 988A, 989A, 9991A & 994A 6080-20, 6081-20, 6086-20, 6088-20 15Amp Sanders / Grinders

14-34-0560 Handle Service Kit — List Price \$7.80 USD 14-34-0570 Handle Service Kit — List Price \$8.00 USD

Left Hand Handle Half **31-44-0840**, Left Hand Handle Half **31-44-0842** Right Hand Handle Half **31-44-0835** for 6080-20, 6081-20, 6086-20, 6088-20 15Amp Sander/Grinders are being **replaced by** one of two Handle Service Kits.

14-34-0560 Handle Service Kit replaces the Left Hand Handle Half 31-44-0842 and Right Hand Handle Half 31-44-0835 used on 6080-20 & 6081-20 product.

14-34-0570 Handle Service Kit replaces the Left Hand Handle Half 31-44-0840 and Right Hand Handle Half 31-44-0835 used on 6086-20 & 6088-20 product.

At the same time, a running change is being made to Motor Housing Assembly **31-50-1751** to improve the fit between Handle Halves and the Motor Housing.

Changing and <u>installing a Handle Service Kit</u> [14-34-0560 or 14-34-0570] <u>will improve the fit between handle halves and motor housing of 'A' series</u> 6080-20, 6081-20, 6086-20, 6088-20 15Amp Sanders / Grinders; the handle Service Kit is designed to eliminate any rocking / looseness of the Sander/Grinder's switch handle.

It is recommend that a **Handle Service Kit** be installed when changing out a 31-50-1751 Motor Housing.

Product with new service handle halves and new motor housing can be identified by a groove present between the handle halves and motor housing, see photo at right. Groove is normal and will be present on all future production.
