
SUBJECT: Armature 'rubbing / dragging' on Field

A occasional complaint of a 5460, 5540 7" / 9" Polisher with it's Armature 'rubbing / dragging' on the Field laminations is caused when the two handle screws closest to the motor housing are tightened down; this distorts the motor housing allowing for the possibility of the armature & field to come into contact with each other.

31-50-0548 Motor Housing, along with the 31-44-1771 Left Handle Half & 31-44-1776 Right Handle Half have been revised and have had ribs / material added. The added material prevents the twisting of the motor housing and eliminates the problem when the two handle screws are tightened.

Both a 31-50-0548 Motor Housing & the Handle Halves 31-44-1771 & 31-44-1776 need to be replaced to properly correct the problem.

The field screw-mounting pads of the revised motor housing are squared on three sides; the old version was circular or rounded. The revised handle halves have long ribs added to the screw hole area. Affected areas —
